



PROJECT INFORMATION

- D&D Ford will construct a new, state of the art 32,642 square foot dealership and service facility on 6.18 acres at 13645 East Wade Hampton Boulevard.
- D&D Ford will annex the 6.18 acre parcel into the City of Greer.
- The construction of the new D&D Ford dealership and service facility represents a total new capital investment of \$7,000,000.
- With the construction of the new D&D Ford dealership and service facility, D&D Ford will preserve 51 jobs. Over the next five years, D&D Ford anticipates adding 10 more jobs to meet increased demand and sales volume.
- The new D&D Ford dealership and service facility will be constructed with elements designed to promote a whole-building approach to sustainability.
- The new D&D Ford dealership and service facility will be state-of-the-art and will be constructed to help D&D Ford continue to focus on its customers. The new dealership and service facility will offer a state-of-the-art body shop and service area, luxurious customer lounge, Café featuring complimentary snacks, and children's area.
- The new D&D Ford will feature an expanded service area equipped to work on medium duty trucks including the F-650 and F-750 models.

HISTORY OF D&D FORD

- D&D Ford was founded in 1937 by Dan Davenport and Earl Duncan.
- D&D Ford was originally located in Greer's historic downtown.
- In 1968, D&D Ford moved to its present location on Wade Hampton Boulevard and was one of the first businesses to locate on Highway 29 in Greer.

- In 1996, D&D Ford was recognized as winner of the Chairman's Award (now referred to as the President's Award), an honor given to the top 100 Ford dealers in the country based on excellence in customer satisfaction.
- D&D Ford has been very active in the Greer community, taking leadership positions in the Greer Chamber of Commerce and Partnership for Tomorrow.
